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RULES FOR THE DAY

1. Teams will be divided into sections based on information provided and trophies will be awarded to a minimum of 2 sections in each age group depending on entry numbers.
2. All players must be underage as at 31/12/2025
3. Each team is to provide an umpire who will operate in a panel system from 9.00am. A badged umpire is preferred, if not badged the umpire must complete the Rules Exam & Foundation or Level 1 Course. Team umpires will be required to make themselves available for finals. If you require us to provide an umpire, please email: reception@waverleynetball.com.au The cost is \$132.00, which includes GST.
4. Each team is to provide a scorer and their own ball & bibs.
5. All matches will be centrally timed from the competition office.
6. Matches will consist of two (2) 8-minute halves with a straight changeover at half time. This may change depending on the number of entries for the tournament.
7. In the event of injury – no time off will be allowed; however, it is understood that the umpire will hold the game to allow the removal of the injured player and the subsequent placing of a substitute. Players may be substituted for injured players. Unlimited substitution in each game.
8. Players may only play with one team on the day. Teams must play in all rostered matches to be eligible to play in the finals. To qualify for the finals, a player must have played in at least one match during the day.
9. Scores will be recorded on iPads provided for each court. The iPads are to always remain at their designated courts, unless told otherwise. The scorer for the first named team is responsible for the official scoring of the match on the iPad, while the scorer for the second named team will be operating the courtside scoreboard.
10. **Trophies:** 10 Trophies for winners and runners up in each section. A memento will be given to all participation in the 11/U section.

Late arrivals to courts for commencement of games. It is the team's responsibility to be present at the court for the start of the game. If any team is not ready to play at the time of the siren, officiating umpires will penalise the offending team 1 goal per minute or part thereof missed once the siren has sounded to commence the game.

In the case of a drawn fixtured game, teams will be awarded two points each. However, in a drawn final, teams are to change ends and play additional time of 3 minutes each end. If the final result is still a draw, teams will change ends and play until one team has scored (3) three goals.
