ENTRY FEES

An \$90.00 Entry fee is payable in addition to the Court Fee listed below per team. The entry fee is due at the time of entry and is non-refundable once fixtures are produced.

1. Saturday Open Premier Competition

- To be played last round on a Saturday
- Matches: Will be 4 x 15 minute with no injury time allowed. Games indoors.
- 15 weeks of competition and 2 weeks of finals.
- Umpires: Supplied
- Court Fee **\$990.00** per season

2. Saturday Open & Junior Competition

2. Female Open Age

- Matches: Will be 4 x 10 minute
- 15 weeks of competition and 2 weeks of finals.
- Umpires: Supplied
- Court Fee \$775.00 per season

Junior game will starts no earlier than 9.10am

2. Female 17 & Under

- Matches: Will be 4 x 10 minute
- 16 rounds and 2 weeks of finals.
- Umpires: Supplied
- Court Fee \$775.00 per season

3. Female 15 & Under

- Matches: Will be 4 x 10 minute
- 15 rounds and 2 weeks of finals.
- Umpires: Supplied
- Court Fee \$735.00 per season

4. Female 13 & Under

(Males under 13 years of age as at the first day of competition, 15th July 2023, may participate)

- Matches: Will be 4 x 10 minute
- 15 rounds and 2 weeks of finals.
- Umpires: Supplied
- Court Fee \$735.00 per season

5.11 & Under

- Matches: Will be 4 x 10 minute
- 16 rounds, no finals.
- Umpires: Supplied
- Court Fee **\$725.00** per season

6. 9 & Under GO

(NET SET GO Membership required)

- Matches: Will be 4 x 10 minute
- 16 rounds, no finals.
- Umpires: Supplied
- Court Fee \$725.00 per season
- Minimum age: must turn 7 in 2023.

No Admittance Fee

is charged to enter the Waverley Netball Centre on competition nights.

TO ENTER:

- All teams must enter ONLINE. Information on how to complete this will be available on the website when entries open. www.waverleynetball.com.au
- The entry fee is non-refundable once teams are accepted into the competition.
- Entries for all teams for the 2023 Spring Competitions must be entered online by <u>9th June 2023</u> at 5.00pm with the entry fee of \$90.00 per team. Entry is not complete unless entry fee is paid.
- An Acceptance Letter notifying you of your Teams acceptance or non-acceptance will be emailed from the Office no later than 17th June 2023.
- Every player must hold a *Netball Victoria Membership* and *Waverley Night NA Membership* before taking the court to play, because you are entering to play with a Netball Victoria Affiliated Association All players, coaches and umpires in Victoria are required to pay an annual membership fee.

Information on how to purchase is included in your teams Acceptance letter.

- Any team and /or player may play Netball at this Centre on each night; however, a player may only play for ONE team in any ONE <u>competition</u>. Please note the different competitions on page 2 & 3, which means players, can play more than one game on a night, but in different competitions.

Walking Netball	Players born on or before 31/12/2012 (11 years and over) and participating in a Walking Netball program or competition.	\$21.00
Off the Court	Committee Members, Administrators, Volunteers, Parents & Spectators (noting players, coaches, umpires, and bench officials must be a current Senior, Junior or AA member)	\$50.00

Prices are inclusive of GST.

Please note players under 7 years of age must register as a NSG participant.

BASIC COMPETITION INFORMATION:

FIXTURES:

Fixtures will be available online on Friday 7th July. Please make sure you read the online fixtures in conjunction with all the association rules and regulations on the association website.

UNIFORMS:

All Clubs/Teams must nominate their playing uniform in the Club/Team Entry Form which must be approved by the Competition. All players must wear their Club/Team's registered playing uniform. New Club/Team's must register their uniform as part of the entry process. Each Team must wear regulation playing bibs. **Sponsorship on playing initials** (bibs) are reserved for the Competition sponsor, no sponsorship is allowed on bibs.

WALKOVERS:

In the event that a Team forfeits prior to the game clock starting at the scheduled time, the game shall be awarded to the non-offending team (4 points, score 10-0 or 15-0 for a premier game). A maximum of 12 nominated players of the non-offending Team shall be credited a game for qualification purposes. Players of the offending Team shall not be credited a game.

A forfeit fine applies for all walkovers given. The fine will be imposed and must be paid before the next fixtured game for the offending team <u>as per the bylaws</u>. Failure to notify the office of a walkover will attract an additional 4 point penalty. (*Change as at 30th June 2023.*)

CLEARANCE:

Players require clearance <u>ONLY</u> if they commence playing a competition with the one team and desire to transfer to another team on <u>that same night</u>, in the same competition during that <u>season</u>. Clearances will not be granted after <u>Round 10</u>. Any player, whose name was not on the original team entry nomination online and desires to drop more than two Grades/Divisions, must make written application to the Management Committee before playing with the new team.

FINALS:

All players in final matches must have played in at least <u>three</u> matches with the team in which they will be playing in the final series. Players playing in Premier League competitions must have played in at least <u>five</u> matches with the team in which they will be playing in the final series.

KIOSK:

Waverley Night Netball Association Inc supply and manage the full Kiosk with viewing area over the indoor courts. You can enjoy a light meal, barista made coffee, cold drinks, ice creams etc. By purchasing from the kiosk, you are supporting the Netball Association.

UMPIRES:

The Association supplies a Panel Umpire for every match. Beginner umpire courses are held regularly.

FIRST AID:

Currently we have First Aid available for competition days and we hope this continues in 2023. First Aid is normally in the Monash Room near the front entrance.
