HOW TO ENTER:

- *All teams must enter ONLINE.* Information on how to complete this will be available on the website when entries open. waverleynetball.com.au (www.wnna.vic.netball.com.au)
- **The entry fee is non-refundable once teams are accepted into the competition.**
- Entries for all teams for the 2022 Autumn Competitions must be entered online by 3rd December 2021 at 5.00pm with the entry fee of \$70.00 per team. **Entry is not complete unless entry fee is paid.**
- An Acceptance Letter notifying you of your Teams acceptance or non-acceptance will be emailed from the Office no later than 10th December 2021.
- Every player must hold a *Netball Victoria Membership* and *Waverley Night NA Membership* before taking the court to play, because you are entering to play with a Netball Victoria Affiliated Association - All players, coaches and umpires in Victoria are required to pay an annual membership fee.

Netball Victoria 2022 Memberships (valid from 1 January 2022 – 31 December 2022)

All members of an Affiliated Association must be registered with NV under one of the following registration types. Players, coaches, umpires, or those with an on-court role must be registered under a Senior, Junior, NetSetGO or All Abilities registration type.

Walking Netball	Players born on or before 31/01/2011 (11 years and over) and participating in a Walking Netball program or competition.	\$20.00
Off the Court	Committee Members, Administrators, Volunteers, Parents & Spectators (noting players, coaches, umpires, and bench officials must be a current Senior, Junior or AA member)	\$48.00

must hold a WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK before carrying out your role in the association

COMPETITION INFORMATION:

A full copy of the competition By-Laws is available at waverleynetball.com.au. This is a couple of rules regarding finals qualifications and borrowing players which changed in the recent update to the by-laws.

FINALS:

All players in final matches must have played in at least three matches with the team in which they will be playing in the final series. Players playing in Premier League competitions must have played in at least five matches with the team in which they will be playing in the final series.

BORROWING PLAYER:

- a) Players shall only be permitted to play in a higher section or age group. Where there are two or more Teams from the same Club graded in the same section, players can only play with their registered Team in that section.
- b) Players may play a maximum of three (3) games in a Team or Club without transferring to that Team or Club for the duration of the season in accordance with Bylaw 3.9.
- c) The borrowed players NVM number, original team and "Borrowed" must be written on the back of the scorecard.

WALKOVER FINE: If a penalty fine is applied for a Walkover given in a Saturday competition, then the fine will be \$50.00.
